

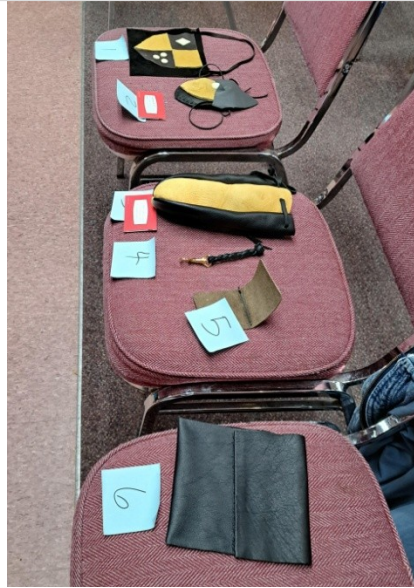
2024 C.S.C.L. ANNUAL MEETING
